Eligibility Requirements for Tuition Aid Bursaries

- Applicants must be in satisfactory academic standing, maintaining a minimum CGPA of 2.0 in order to be eligible for Tuition Aid Bursary funds.
- Tuition Aid Bursaries are available for students who are enrolled in a full-time course load (4+ courses) or a part-time course load (1-3 courses).
- Some Tuition Aid Bursaries may require supporting documents. Please make sure to submit all required documents for bursary consideration.
- The Tuition Aid Bursary will become a loan that must be repaid if a Tuition Aid Bursary recipient does not meet the following conditions:
 - Student must complete the academic term(s) and not be dismissed for disciplinary reason.
 - An academic term is considered to be complete when all the required work is submitted, including the writing of the final examination.
