NOTES:

- 1. The Master of Theology degree will be awarded when the student successfully completes all listed courses attaining a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. All courses counted toward the ThM degree must be B- or above. A student choosing the thesis option must also successfully defend his/her thesis.
- 2. Students are normally expected to complete the ThM within a maximum of 7 years of beginning the program.
- 3. Students whose subject area is Spiritual Theology may substitute INTD 0857 ThM Interdisciplinary Seminar: Spiritual Theology for INTD 0851 Text and Interpretation.
- 4. In lieu of a thesis, students taking the non-thesis option shall take two additional courses in their subject area as approved by the Director.
