SEMESTER 1-3 PAYMENT PLANS:

- 1. Students Applying for Government Student Aid
 - a. **Deadline:** Submit all required documents for your government student aid application by June 30, 2025.
 - b. **Payment Requirement:** Any tuition fees not covered by student aid must be paid in four installments on the following dates: August 30, 2025; October 31, 2025; February 28, 2026; April 30, 2026
- 2. Students NOT Applying for Government Student Aid
 - a. **Payment Requirement:** The outstanding tuition balance must be paid in four installments on the following dates: June 30, 2025; September 30, 2025; December 31, 2025; and March 31, 2026

How to Calculate Your Installments:

- 1. Subtract any initial payment (e.g., \$500 deposit) and expected scholarships or bursaries from your total tuition².
- 2. Divide the remaining balance by four to determine your installment amount.

Example: $[$34,856 (FSL total) - $500 (Deposit) - $750 (Bursary)] \div 4 = $8,401.50 payment installment$

*Outstanding balance is subject to monthly interest at 12% per annum

SEMESTER 4 PAYMENT PLANS will be released in 2026.

PAYMENT METHODS:

- 1. Online Payment through a Canadian financial institution (preferred payment method to keep Tyndale's processing fee low): Please add "Tyndale University" as a payee to your "bills" list. The account number will be your Student ID number. If your student ID is shorter than 9 digits, please add '000' in front of your student ID number. ex. 000123456. Please note that online payments take 2 business days to reach our bank, please allow for sufficient processing time.
- 2. Cheques: Please send a cheque by mail or drop off a cheque at the campus Reception. (please make the cheque payable to "Tyndale")
- **3. PayMyTuition** (preferred payment method for International Students): Tyndale University has partnered with PayMyTuition for international tuition payments. With PayMyTuition, you can pay your tuition payments from any bank, in any country in any currency at better than bank exchange rates. PayMyTuition is fast, simple, and cost-effective.
- **4. Visa or MasterCard**: Please submit your payment at https://pay.tyndale.ca. A 2% charge will be added to all credit card transactions to cover transaction costs.

LOGGING INTO MYTYNDALE

How do I access my MyTyndale account to view my statement?

- 1. Please visit https://mytyndale.ca/
- 2. Log in with your MyTyndale username and password. If you do not know your password, please reset it online.
- 3. Click on the Financial Services tab (near the top of the page).
- 4. Click My Statement (on the left hand side of the page).
- 5. Click View My Statement (on the left hand side of the page) to view your statement.

Which financial institutions can I make online payments from?

You can pay for your tuition fees online if you bank with one of the following financial institutions: CIBC, TD Canada Trust, Bank of Montreal, Scotiabank, Royal Bank, HSBC, Simplii Financial or Tangerine.

When will the government student aid applications be available?

Government student aid applications for the 2024-2025 academic year will be available in Spring 2024.

How do I apply for government student aid?

If I am applying for government student aid for semesters 1-3, do I need to apply again for semester 4?

Yes, you will complete the 2025-2026 application for semesters 1-3. When the 2026-2027 application becomes available in Spring 2026, you can apply for government student aid for semester 4.

Do you have a tip sheet for applying?

Yes, there is an OSAP Tip Sheet available for BEd students to help guide them through the application process. While the tip sheet is specifically tailored for OSAP, students applying for government student aid in other provinces can also benefit from the information provided.

MISCELLANEOUS

Will I get a notification about the payment deadlines?

Yes, you will receive a reminder in your MyTyndale email account approximately 2 weeks before the payment deadlines. These emails are sent as a courtesy and must not be relied upon. It is the responsibility of the student to adhere to the deadlines listed in this form.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION REFUND SCHEDULE 2025-2026

When can I expect my income tax receipt?

Tuition tax receipts (T2202 & T4A) for the calendar years 2010-2024 are available through your MyTyndale account. 2025 tax receipts will be available on MyTyndale in February 2026.

REFUND SCHEDULE

Will I receive a refund if I drop out of the program?

The refund amount will be calculated for each course based on the percentage of completion and the approved withdrawal date.

Deadlines	Refund
Less than 20% of course duration	100%*
Less than 30% of course duration	80%**
Less than 40% of course duration	70%**
Less than 50% of course duration	60%**
50% of course duration	50%**
More than 50% of course duration	0%**

^{*} Drop Fee of \$100 per course will be charged.

^{**} Refund % applies to Tuition, Resource Fee, Student Activity Fee and Graduation Fee. Administration fee is not refundable.
