2. All MA Thanatology students must complete a year-long internship in their major area. This internship is normally completed during the last year of study. The internship is administered by the Tyndale Seminary Internship Program (TSIP) Director.
3. Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 and a minimum of 18 courses are required to graduate.
4. Students are normally expected to complete the MA Thanatology within a maximum of 7 years from beginning the program.
