I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

Revised: June 21, 2022

This course is an introduction to the systematic study of Christian doctrines according to the Evangelical tradition. Historical (diachronical) and thematic (synchronical) aspects are explored in each major Christian doctrine. The learning outcomes of this course are in line with the learning outcome of the M.Div. Program which is to train pastors and missionaries for the Chinese Church. Hence, special emphasis is placed on the application of these doctrines in evangelism, apologetics, pastoral ministries, missiological considerations and theological contextualization. Class discussions and assignments are designed to encourage the students to apply the contents of the course in these related fields.

E. ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING 作業及評核

Class Participation: Attendance, Discussion, Assigned Readings (10%)

The students are required to read the assigned texts and class notes according to the class schedule, and prepare to interact in class with other student.

2. Critical reflection on the reading materials.

(30%)

Read through the assigned reading materials and write up 4 critical reflections 3 page single space each (7.5% each) on a certain theme of the reading materials. This assignment develops the Learning Outcome 1.1 concerning the development of the student's cognitive understanding about formulizing a consistent system of theology.

3. Class Presentation: select an aspect of a doctrine, present the research in class, and lead the class discussion on this aspect of the chosen doctrine. (30%)

This assignment encourages the student to research the selected aspect of a certain doctrine, formulate a biblical position, and dialogue with the peer on this specific doctrine. Class presentation is 20 minutes per student (15 min. presentation, 5 min. discussion). This assignment targets the Learning Outcome 1.2, 1.3, 1.4 to measure the student's ability to apply the understanding of Christian Doctrine in preaching, pastoral counseling, teaching, writing, and apologetic defense of Christian Faith.

4. Paper: 15-page paper on an issue of a selected doctrine

This assignment encourages the student to do a scholarly research on a specific issue of the student's choice on a certain doctrine. It could be a study of a theologian, or exegesis of the scripture, or certain aspects of a doctrine. This assignment develops the Learning Outcome 2.1, 2.2 concerning the writing skill and development of personal theological position.
