# I. COURSE DESCRIPTION 課程介紹

A systematic study of Christian doctrines according to the evangelical tradition. Topics covered include prolegomena, revelation and the doctrine of the Word, the doctrines of God, creation, and humanity. Special emphases are placed upon the application of these doctrines in evangelism, apologetics, pastoral ministries, missiological considerations and theological contextualization.

此課程基於福音信仰去系統闡釋基督教教義,每一個教義都依循歷史和主題的兩個層面去 開展。此課目的與道學碩士目的相符,乃是要培育華人教會的教牧及宣教同工。故此,課 程設計重點在於教義能應用在傳福音、護教、教牧、宣教及神學本土化等方面。教室討論 及作業之目的在於鼓勵學員將所學的知識應用在不同的有關領域上。

# II. LEARNING OUTCOMES 學習成果

At the end of the course, 讀畢本科後:

- 1. Learning Outcomes in the Cognitive Domain: 認知目的
  - 1.1. Students will develop a comprehensive and in-depth understanding and appreciation of the Christian Doctrines of Theological Method, Bibliology, Doctrine of God, Creationism, and Anthropology.

- 1.2. Students will be able to apply the understanding of Christian doctrines to pastoral ministries in preaching, counseling, teaching and writing.

- 1.3. Students will learn to analyze and synthesize the knowledge of these doctrines in the context of evangelism and the defense of Christian faith.

- 1.4. Students will gain insights and evaluate various missiological issues in the Missions field.
  - 學員將可以處理一些宣教工場上所遇上的神學問題。

- 2. Learning Outcomes in the Affective Domain: 感知目的
  - 2.1. Engage the students in the process of theological contextualization and indigenization. Students are expected to develop his/her theology in the Chinese context. 學員將進行個人神學本土和本色化的進程。
  - 2.2. Students will organize and develop their own theological system and positions on various issues.

## D. ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING 作業及評核

Class Participation: Attendance, Discussion, Assigned Readings (10%)

The students are required to read the assigned texts and class notes according to the class schedule and prepare to interact in class with other student.

2. Critical reflection on the reading materials.

assignment develops the Learning Outcome 1.1 concerning the development of the student's cognitive understanding about formulizing a consistent system of theology.

**3.** Final Paper: 15-page paper on an issue of a selected doctrine (60%)

This assignment encourages the student to do a scholarly research on a specific issue of the student's choice on a certain doctrine. It could be a study of a theologian, or exegesis of the scripture, or certain aspects of a doctrine. This assignment develops the Learning Outcome 1 and 2 to measure the student's ability to apply the understanding of Christian Doctrine in the development of personal theological position and apologetic defense of Christian Faith.

#### **Turnitin Text-Matching Software**
