I. COURSE DESCRIPTION 課程簡介

A study of central methods and interpretative principles involved in discerning the meaning of the biblical text. Topics covered include essential steps in interpreting the Bible, the variety of methods and approaches available to the contemporary student of Scripture, historical and theological issues arising out of the interpretative task, the relationship between the testaments, word studies and literary genre. Students learn to use the standard tools of advanced biblical research.

2. Presentation and Discussion 課堂發表及討論(15%)

Students are required to do one oral presentations on the approaches of biblical interpretation and participate in discussion in the class.

學員須就聖經詮釋的進路中選擇一個方法分別在課堂上進行七分鐘口頭報告,並且回 應同學及老師的提問。

3. Methodology Paper 詮釋方法論報告(20%,1000-1500字,雙行行距,12/05繳 交)

Students are required to select a complete unit of biblical passage (the students will require the approval from the instructor for the selected passage) and then students must provide their own methodology and steps to interpret the passage. For each step, students are required to provide its goal and procedure and how it relates to other steps (1000-1500 words, double-spaced).

4. Exegesis Paper 釋經報告(35%,5500-6000字,雙行行距,12/05繳交)

Students are expected to write an exegetical paper on the previous passage by following their own exegesis steps (5500-6000 words, double-spaced).
