

MDiv Counselling Major – Pastoral Care and Counselling Track – Electives

Students in the Pastoral Care and Counselling Track have 8 electives. Normally, students will be required to take 5 of the 8 electives as Counselling electives. This does not mean that they all have to COUN **** course codes. Some other courses will be deemed to be equivalent to a counselling course.

The following is a list of those courses that we would deem to be acceptable as Counselling electives for the Pastoral Care and Counselling Track:

- SPIR 0529: Spiritual Warfare
- SPIR 0601: Finding your Way: Principles of Spiritual Direction
- SPIR 0604: Exploring the Dream Experience in Christian Spirituality
- SPIR 0608: Spaces of the Heart: Dynamics and Disciplines of the Spiritual Life
- MISS 0681: Issues in Missionary Spiritual and Psychological Health
- MISS 0688: Cross-Cultural Communication
- THEO 0836: Evil & Suffering
- Any YMIN course

The other 3 electives can be “free electives” from other disciplines.
